I am thrilled to share with you our assessment outcomes from this academic year. You will see from the tables that we are at, or in some cases, well above the national average throughout the school.

This represents a second year of improved outcomes for children at Beckfield and the second of many to come. Outcomes like this have never been achieved in the history of the school.

It fills me with extreme pride to see how well your children have done this year. As I always say, these tests do not tell the entire story of a child's life and learning. There is lots more to be proud of but it is really great to be able to give children opportunities to succeed academically.

This year, we reflect that we have also been inspected by Ofsted and were judged to be 'Good' in all areas of school. This is a tremendous accomplishment and again represents a significant positive shift in the history of the school, previously judged to be 'Requires Improvement' and 'Inadequate'.

Earlier, this year, some of our Year 6 children were successful in getting through to the global final for the GoIT competition held by Tata Consultancy Services. This was a phenomenal achievement and they made us all proud.

We celebrated our Girls' Football Team winning the league this year also. What a triumph!

More recently, some of our children were selected to take part in music events and performances in and out of school. We have performed at Headingley Stadium and Leeds Arena this year and those were incredible experiences for our children.

We were also awarded the Primary Science Quality Mark after a rigorous process of gathering and submitting evidence to show our commitment to teaching children about how the world works.

Next year will see us work towards additional nationally recognised awards for the school, particularly around the arts and music. We know this is one of our strengths and something lots of us are passionate about continuing to develop.

There are lots of talented individuals working together at Beckfield to give your children opportunities to succeed. I am proud of the team we have going into 2025-26 and I know, as a community of staff, children, parents and friends, we will continue to achieve great things.
